KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That  
I, Theron Earle, of the County of Greenville

In the State aforesaid,  
of Twenty five Dollars to me in consideration of the sum  
and before the sealing of these presents by Monaghan Mills, a corporation duly chartered under the laws of said State  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and  
release unto the said Monaghan Mills, that certain tract of land situated in the County and State of said  
County of Greenville, State aforesaid, being in the City of Greenville, State aforesaid, bounded by the  
beginning at a point 27 1/2 rods Middle of Paris Bridge Road, thence with track  
822-310-815, to take 14 1/4 feet from center of said Spur Track, thence along line parallel to, and  
distant 14 1/4 feet from center of said Spur Track, 40 to take the same 822-30 W 11, 60 to have  
line on South side of said Spur Track 14 1/4 feet distant therefrom, thence bounds the East in  
line parallel to the center of said Spur Track 14 1/4 feet from said center, 695.05 acres said  
tract Middle of Paris Bridge Road, thence with middle of said Road 4115.258 N 79.70 to beginning  
point having been one hundred and three (100) acres more or less.  
Also that certain other tract of land parallel in the County and State aforesaid, west of the  
City of Greenville and Ready River, with following lines; Beginning at a point in center of Ready  
River 14 1/4 feet south of center of Spur Track Monaghan Mills, thence in a Northwest direction in a  
line parallel to, and distant 14 1/4 feet from the Middle of said Spur Railroad track 810 to point, thence  
N 44 W 413.60 to point near said Spur Track, thence across the said track N 14° 14' E 47 to point  
therein N 44 W 483.70 to point, thence N 41.39 E 112.50 to point 12 1/4 feet from center of said Spur Track,  
thence in a Northeast direction in line parallel to, and distant 14 1/4 feet from the center  
of said track 810 to Middle of Ready River, thence across said Railroad track twenty-five  
feet to the beginning, containing fifty four (54) acres more or less.

defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Monaghan Mills its successors,

Heirs and Assigns against me and my Heirs, and every person whomsoever, lawfully  
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
