west side of Mt. Greenville and Laurens public road, about two miles from  
Greenville Court House, on waters of Reedy River, containing eighty-six (86) acres, more  
or less, having according to survey prepared by H. A. Hudson, July 31, 1898 and plat accompanying  
same, the following outlet and boundaries viz.: Beginning in corner in the middle of Laurens  
Road, and running thence alongside road, N 37° W 8.80 ch. to a stone 3x, in middle of Road, thence S. 53° W.  
2.1.30 ch. to stone 3x; thence S. 23° W. 13.90, crossing branch, to a stone 3x, thence E. 42° N 15.70 ch. to stone 3x;
