Presents:

That I the said Emma Tinsley in consideration of the foregoing premises, and the further consideration of one dollar to me in hand, paid at and before the sealing of these Presents by W. A. Hammett, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have disposed of the custody and tuition of the said Willie Tinsley unto the said W. A. Hammett and his heirs, for and during the whole of such time as the said Willie Tinsley shall remain under the age of twenty one years, and the possession of the said Willie Tinsley to the said W. A. Hammett and his heirs is hereby conveyed.

To Have and To Hold the said Willie Tinsley for such time as aforesaid unto the said W. A. Hammett and his heirs:

Provided, That the said W. A. Hammett and his heirs shall at all times during the time aforesaid provide for the said Willie Tinsley in sickness and in health, and at all times supply him with suitable food and clothing

and shall also cause the said Willie Tinsley within such time to read and write and give to him such further education and advantages as the said W. A. Hammett may feel inclined to do.
