This agreement and entered into this 4th day of September, A. D. 1901 by and between Mrs. Lou Jones widow, the mother of two children, named respectively, Clarence age 6 years and Willie, age 4 years, and John A. Jones, the grandfather of said children both of the State and County aforesaid: witnesseth: That the said Mrs. Lou Jones, widow and mother, as aforesaid being in destitute circumstances, which renders her unable to provide for the comfort of her said two children, hereby agrees to and with the John A. Jones, that he shall take them under his care and provide for them such support as he is able to give and such as their condition in life demands until they are 21 years old, to treat them as his own children and rear them under the influence of Christianity and giving them the aid and comfort in all matters that are required of the old and demanded by young.

I, John A. Jones, accept the trust and agree to all its provisions.

It is agreed that the mother is to have the right and privilege in sickness or in health, to visit them or have them visit her.
