Whereas, on the fifth day of March, 1894, one Frank Hammond, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State, executed and delivered to me Eva P. Blassingame his deed of conveyance to the property hereinafter described; and whereas, the consideration for said deed (which was recorded in office of Register of Mesne Conveyances for Greenville County, in said State, on July 5, 1894, in Deed Book "A.A.A." at page 519) was paid to the said Frank Hammond by the late Wm.F. Blassingame, the husband of said Eva P. Blassingame; And whereas, the said Eva P. Blassingame departed this life intestate on the 12th day of September, 1894, leaving as her sole heirs at law her husband, the said Wm.F. Blassingame, her father, W.S. Gregory, her four sisters, Minnie M. Gregory, Lizzie F. Gregory, Kate G. Dillard and Fannie G. Browning, and her two minor brothers, Victor Q. Gregory and Virgil Gregory; And whereas, a deed was prepared, bearing date the 20th day of May, A.D. 1895, and setting forth the above facts, which deed was duly executed by W.S. Gregory individually and as guardian, Minnie M. Gregory, Kate G. Dillard, Fannie G. Browning and Lizzie F. Gregory, none of whom claimed any interest in said land; said deed releasing to said Wm.F. Blassingame all of the right, title and interest of said Grantors in said land; but through inadvertence the said deed was not properly witnessed, and therefore cannot now be recorded; And whereas a suit was instituted in the Court of Common Pleas for the County of Greenville, in said State, on the sixth day of June, A.D. 1895, by the said Victor Q. Gregory and Virgil Gregory, then minors above the age of the fourteen years and appearing by their guardian ad-litem, the said W.S. Gregory, against the said Wm.F. Blassingame, for partition of the said tract of land, in which cause a consent decree was duly signed on July 11, 1895, by Hon. Jos. H. Earle, presiding Judge, ordering the sale of said land and the payment of one-seventh of the proceeds of such sale to plaintiffs' guardian; And whereas said Wm.F. Blassingame became the purchaser of said land at such sale and complied with the terms of sale and received a deed of conveyance for said land, executed by D.P. Verner, Master, bearing date August 10th, 1895 and recorded in the office above mentioned on September 3, 1895, in Deed Book "B.B.B." at page 650; And whereas, said Wm.F. Blassingame executed and delivered to Marion B. Leach a deed of conveyance to said land, bearing date January 7, 1897, and recorded in said office on January 26, 1897, in Deed Book "C.C.C." at page 568; And whereas, the said W.S. Gregory has since departed this life, leaving as his sole heirs and distributees his six surviving children above mentioned; And whereas, it is now desired to remedy the apparent defect in the title to said tract of land, and to clear said title without a resort to proceedings in Court; Now, therefore, Know All Men by these presents that we, the said Minnie M. Gregory, Lizzie F. Gregory, Victor Q. Gregory, Virgil Gregory, Kate G. Dillard and Fannie G. Browning, sole heirs-at-law and distributees of said W.S. Gregory, being all of the full age of Twenty-one years, in consideration of the matters hereinabove set forth and also of the sum of Three Dollars to us in hand paid by the said Marion B. Leach at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold, released and quit-claimed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release and forever quitclaim unto the
