on the South and by a twenty foot alley on the East half
way between Main Street and Townes Street, and having
the following measurements: Beginning on an iron pin
on a corner of Townes Street and said thirteen foot alley
between me and Dr. Dargan running thence along said
alley N. 70° E 205 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to an iron pin corner of said alley
and the said twenty foot alley, thence along said twenty foot
alley N. 70° E 60 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 70° W. 205 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet
to an iron pin on Townes Street, thence along Townes
