KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, J. H. Morgan and W. H. Austin Jr., partners as Morgan and Austin of the City and County of Greenville in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of twenty-five hundred Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by Sadie N. Rowland (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Sadie N. Rowland all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the Fifth Ward of the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, having following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake on River Street, at corner of lot of Walter West, and running thence with West's line S. 71° 30' E. one hundred and fifty-five (155) feet to a stake on corner of lots numbered three (3) and fifteen (15) of the McBee purchase; thence S. 2° 20' W. forty-four (44) feet to a stake; thence with line of Lot number five (5), belonging to Mrs. Mary J. Logan, N. 71° W. one hundred and fifty-one 4/10 (151.4) feet to River Street; thence with said River Street, sixty and six-tenths (60 6/10) feet to the beginning corner; being known as Lot numbered four (4) of the land conveyed by Alex McBee to Mountain City Land and Improvement Company on January 31, 1895 (see E.B.R. "177"), and being the same lot of land conveyed to us by said Mountain City Land and Improvement Company by deed bearing date April 30, 1901, and recorded in office of Register of Deeds Conveyances for said State and County on May 3, 1901, in Deed Book "I.I.I." at page 65; see also deed to us from D.J. Anderson bearing date April 2, 1901, and recorded in said office in Deed Book "H.H.H." at page 210; in both of the deeds to us the line first above mentioned as running S. 71° 30' E. between said lot and Walter West's lot is described as being one hundred and sixty-five (165) feet long; this error arose in copying a plat made by J. E. Sirrine in February, 1895, on which original plan, said line is described as being one hundred and fifty-five (155) feet in length, and this is its true length.
