

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA.) DEED OF TRUST: Mrs Mary Orr Earle
 WHEREAS heretofore to wit: on or about the first day of January A.D. 1884 I, Mary Orr-
 Earle, under my former name of Mary Prevost, did execute and deliver unto the late
 James Lawrence Orr my certain deed in writing, bearing date the said first day of
 January 1881, and duly recorded in the office of the Clerk of Court for Anderson County
 in said State on the 26th day of January 1881 in Book T.T. at pages 396 & 400; and therby
 by convey and transfer unto the said James Lawrence Orr certain real and personal property
 in said deed described in trust to collect the rents and proffits thereof and to pay over
 the same to me during my natural life and upon my death to pay over the corpus of the
 trust estate freed of all trust, to my son Marshall Blair Prevost, if he should then be
 alive or if he should not be then alive, to pay over and distribute the same among his
 lawful issues according to the provisions of the statutes of Distributions of the State
 of South Carolina; and in the event of the death of the said Marshall Blair Prevost during
 my lifetime leaving no lawful issue surviving him then in trust to receive the same
 the estate to me or to my legal representatives as the case might be, freed and relieved
 of all trusts; and whereas the said James Lawrence Orr departed this life on the 26th day
 of February 1905, and it is necessary that a trustee be appointed in his stead;
 Now therefore know all men by these presents that I the said Mary Orr Earle, in Pursuance
 of the terms of said trust deed and in execution of a power reserved to myself therein do
 hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my nephew, Lawrence Orr Patterson trustee
 successor to the said James Lawrence Orr under the said trust deed; and in consideration
 of the premises and of the sum of one dollar to me paid by the said Lawrence Orr Patterson
 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) I, have granted bargained sold, and released
 transferred assigned and set over, and do by these presents grant, bargain sell and release
 transfer, assign, and set over unto the said Lawrence Orr Patterson all that certain lot
 piece, or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the first ward of the City of Greenville,
 in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, on the North East corner of
 Richardson and West Washington Streets, bounded on the North by lot belonging to me
 on the North-East by lot of John W. Harris, and on the East by lot of J. Lee Green, the lot
 hereby conveyed being the same whereon is situated the Hotel Building now known
 as the Exchange Hotel, later as Southern Hotel, and now Blue Ridge Hotel, and being the same
 which was conveyed to the said James L. Orr as trustee for myself by the late Dr. J.
 Verner Master for said County by deed bearing date Oct 3rd 1895 and duly recorded in the
 office of the register of Deeds Conveyance for said County on Oct 4, 1895 in Deed Book
 "A.A." at page 812.

And also all other property, real, personal and mixed whatsoever sort and wheresoever situate
 including all moneys, securities, evidences of debt, choses in action and other assets of
 every description of which the said James L. Orr, at the time of his death, was seized or
 possessed, or to which he was entitled as trustee for me. Together with all and singular
 rights hereditament and appurtenances to the said premises belonging to it, save
 without or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises and all
 interest in them unto the said Lawrence Orr Patterson, and his successors and assigns.

In trust nevertheless said law to hold the same, and to let and to lease the same
 for such term or terms, and for such rent or rents, as he shall see fit.

executed by myself to the said James L. Orr and first hereinbefore referred to
 and I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to which and forever
 defend all and singular the ^{said} premises unto the said Lawrence Orr Patterson and his successors
 him and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever claiming or to
 claim the same or any part thereof; and in the event that, before the trust hereby created
 have been fully executed, the said Lawrence Orr Patterson shall die, become insane, renounce
 the trust, or neglect or refuse or become incapable or unfit to fulfill the same, I hereby
 reserve to myself and shall have the right to appoint in writing a successor, and to
 continue to exercise this power from time to time as often as circumstances may require, which
 trustee so appointed by me shall administer this trust with like effect in all respects to
 such appointee had been named herein; and the receipt of such successor to the personal
 representative of the former trustee shall in every instance be an ample legal acquittance
 and discharge of such former trustee for the corpus of the trust estate and as an express
 condition of the acceptance by the said Lawrence Orr Patterson of the trusts hereby conferred
 neither he nor his estate shall be liable for any deterioration or loss which may occur in
 management of the estate hereby granted, nor for any interest not actually received by him
 nor for any cause, matter or thing except gross neglect or fraud on his part; and it is so
 expressly understood and stipulated.

 year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and five (1905) and in the one hundred and
 ninth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
