This agreement made this 9th day of Mar on A.D. 1905 between Fannie Peden of Greenville Post Office Greenville, County, South Carolina, of the first part, hereinafter designated as "Land Owner", and National Light & Thorium Company, a corporation of Delaware, of the second part, hereinafter designated as "Company".

Know all men by these presents that for the consideration hereinafter mentioned, the Land Owner hereby grants to the Company the Moenkite sand contained in or on her land in Greenville, County, South Carolina, described as follows: lying and being on the waters of Leiderman's Creek, containing six (6) acres, more or less, and adjoining lands of R.C. Willimon.

The said land is bounded on the west by the Leiderman's Creek, and on the east by the property of the Company, and on the south by the property of R.C. Willimon, and on the north by the property of the Company.
