Know all men by these presents that I Solomon Jones of the State of North Carolina and County of Henderson in consideration of seventy five dollars to me paid by William Jones of the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said William Jones a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being situate in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, on Oil Camp Creek waters of Middle Saluda River, beginning on a small Black Oak N. of Creek and runs thence South 20 East crossing Creek 35 poles to a Spanish Oak; corner of Wm Jones, land thence South 70 west 5^{1/2} rods to a Black Oak thence S. 50 1/2 West 2.30 rods to small white Oak thence N. 29 1/5 West 7.60 rods Crossing Creek to a sweet Gum, begining corner of Wm Jones land, thence N. 25 West 7 rods to a stake, thence N. 7.70 East 35 rods to the begining containing 10 acres, more or less, joining lands of Wm Jones and W.L. 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TO National Light & Thorium Company

This agreement made this 13th day of April A.D. 1905 between J.T. Childres and A.L. Childres of R.F.D #5 Piedmont Postoffice, Greenville County, South Carolina, of the first part hereinafter designated as "Land-Owner", and National Light & Thorium Company a corporation of Delaware, of the second part, hereinafter designated as "Company",

WITNESSETH: That for the consideration hereinafter mentioned the land owners sell and release to the Company the Monazite sand contained in or on their land in Greenville County, South Carolina, described as follows: the beds and runs of the streams on their land lying and being in Grove Township Greenville County, South Carolina, on and near the waters of

Beedy Fork Creek adjoining lands of J.F. Loftis, Mrs. Jessie Hughes, P.D. Huff, J.L. Cox and others containing two hundred acres, more or less.

The Company shall have the exclusive right for the recovery of the Monazite on said lands and if said silver, diamonds, or other precious minerals be found thereon the same shall be the property of the land owners. The Company shall have extensive water rights with authority to
