Whitmire all that piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, in the western part of Greenville Township, containing seventy-nine acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, and courses and distances, to wit: Beginning at a stake in mouth of branch on Saluda river 3x on thence S.64-1/2 E 10.86 to a Poplar, thence S.74 E 25.50 to a stone thence N44 E 5.92 to a bend in road Mett's corner (now a stone), thence N.19 E.7.50 to a white oak, thence N 1/2 W 12.65 to a stone, thence N 68 E 11.00 x 582-200 7.90 to corner in road, thence S 9.90 W pine, thence N. 82 3/4 W 26.60 to stone on river, thence down the river to the begining corner, and being a part of the land conveyed to B. Fannie Whitmire by William H.
