KNOWN ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That Stone Land Company has agreed to sell to A.E. Sussex a certain lot or tract of land in the county of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on South side of Earle street, between Towns and Wilton streets, having a frontage on Earle street of sixty-five and one-half feet and a depth of two hundred feet, and being the eastern one-half portion of lot No. 4, as shown on the plat recorded in Register of Mesne Conveyance office in book V. V. page 542, on condition that he shall pay all taxes thereon and also the sum of four hundred fifty re/100 dollars in the following manner: Ten dollars cash and ten dollars or more on the first day of each calendar month after date until the full purchase price is paid, with interest on same from date at eight per cent per annum until paid, to be computed and paid annually, and if unpaid to bear interest until paid at same rate as principal, and in case said sum or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or through legal proceedings of any kind, then in condition the sum of one per cent for attorney's fee, and said A.E. Sussex, as tenant holding over at termination, or contrary to the terms of his lease, and shall be entitled to claim and receive, or retain if already paid the sum of seventy-five dollars per year for rent, or by way of liquidated damages, or may enforce payment of said note.
