Barr all that certain lot of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, on the east side of the Boncombe Road, about three miles from Greenville Court House, containing Twenty-four and three-fourths (24-3/4) acres, more or less, Beginning at an iron pin on side of the road, corner of N.W. Harley; thence N. 38 E. 27.50 to Creek; thence with Creek N. 20 1/2 E. 5.10 to iron pin on Creek; thence N. 81 W. 30.15 to iron pin on Boncombe Road thence with said road S. 4 1/4 E. 11.50 to beginning, same being part of a tract of land conveyed by said Louise B. Perry to Piedmont Saving and Investment Company.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Mrs. C.I. Charles, her heirs and assigns forever: subject however, to the limitations and conditions hereinbefore imposed.

and it does hereby bind itself and its successors in office to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Mrs. C.I. Charles, heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors in office and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
