(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. D. Neelby his heirs and assigns all of my right title and interest in and to all of that certain piece parcel of land containing but hundred and seven and one-half acres more or less situated and lying in the County of Greenville, in the State and County aforesaid and being a part of the original tract of George, with all and sundry appurtenances thereto, bounded as follows: Beginning at a point 30 rods N. 87° W. from the corner of the said tract with the property of John D. Garrison, thence N. 87° W. 30 rods to the bridge over the Little River, thence N. 87° W. 10 rods to the corner of the said tract, thence N. 87° W. 10 rods to the bridge over the Little River, thence N. 87° W. 10 rods to the beginning corner. The same being a part of the tract of land contained in the aforesaid tract of Neelby & Newbridge held by C. B. Jarrett, dated March 9, 1862, except a part of the property which lies in the Creek, abandoned by said deeds, reference thereto being made with more fully appear'

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said J. D. Neelby and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And John D. Neelby do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said C. B. Jarrett and his

Heirs and Assigns, against every person, and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
