Robinson, Wm. Barton and others being the same tract of land of which the said Susan Elizabeth Pitman, died seized and possessed and said to contain Two hundred and fifteen acres, more or less; our interest in the said tract being a one fifth undivided interest each.

Heirs and Assigns, against us and our Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
