(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Placant Plaintiff*, all that piece of land containing three and one-half acres more or less, situated being on the County and State Highway about six rods from the Greenlee Court House near the old Forest Road adjoining lands of Sam Rosemon, James Gandy, and wife located on the following line beginning at a stone 3 p.m. on the North east corner running N. 84° 10' E. 70' to a stone 3 p.m. on Sam Rosemon's line S. 24° E. 180' to a stone 3 p.m. on the same line S. 85° E. 71' 14" to a stone 3 p.m. on and Darkethorn's line S. 23° E. 480' to the beginning. The property being *lot 70, 1/2 front of County Line Road* which belongs to the Estate of my father, William Ward deceased, and is my divided and equal interest in the same.
