Gray, Master, Contain forty Eight Acres more By Estimation, more or less.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said G.W. Plumley and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself and Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said G.W. Plumley and

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
