Receiver of the State and County aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bascom W Broome, all that piece parcel and tract of Land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, and State aforesaid, and within Township containing forty four (44) acres more or less, on the Laurens Road, lying on a branch of Maple Creek Branch Waters of Reedy River, and having 3x137 rods, bearing S.W. to the Beginning corner conveyed to me by D. J. Ulmer Master by Deed bearing date the 10th day of October 1900 and recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds, Greenville, now said County in the year 1904 page 147, and adjoining lands of John Hill, Mrs Mary Baldwin P. S. Sherrill and others.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Bascom W Broome, his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Bascom W Broome, his

Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my wife Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
