(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said (C) Morris, all her claim had or parcel of Land Situate in the County of Greenville in said State partly within the Village of Ingelena Creek on the north east side of the Jones Gap Road, and of the road leading to Col. H. W. P. R. on Water of Conroe River having the following tract & bounds to wit Beginning at stake 3x n m on line 2000 on boundary of J. D. Cooper and North side of a 20 foot street thence 27 8/4 E 15° 40' to stake 3x s m then N. 17 W with line formerly of (C) Morris 4.40 to stone 3x n m then N. 51° W 36.10 to stake 3x n m on N. E. side of a 30 foot street thence N 31° E 3.87 along said street to stake 3x n m then N. 83.7 14.500 with N. W. side of Lot #18 and #17 to stake 3x n m on line so parallel with said 12 1/2 track and 60 feet from middle thereof thence N 31° E 151 with said line to stake 3x n m then N. 69° E 5.00 to stake 3x n m on N.
