V. Nabors on the day of August, 1898, by Joseph P. Nabors et al. and duly filed in office of R. M. C. Corp., said County and recorded in Vol. Page on the day of Containing 21 1/2 acres more or less, and bounded by lands of J. H. Gray, W. H. Hopkins, Harrison Bros. & other lands of J. V.
