 Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
 Manly L. Brant,
 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Manly L. Brant all of two pieces, parcels or lots of land
 lying, situate and being in the state aforesaid, Greenville County, near Morgan
 Mill, and being the same lot conveyed to me by Mary A. Morgan, being lots No. 16 & 17,
 of subdivision known as Morgan Hill, Miles and Bounds to wit:
 Lot No. 16. Beginning at an iron pin in line with O'Neal street, corner of lot No. 13 and
 thence running with O'Neal Street N. 82 1/4 E. 60 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot No.
 17, thence S. 74 1/4 E. 200 feet to iron pin corners of lots No. 29 & 30 thence S. 82 1/4 W. 100 feet to
 iron pin corners of lots No. 29, 28 & 16 thence N. 74 1/4 W. 200
 Also lot No. 17. Beginning at a stake corner on south side of O'Neal Street and running
 thence with O'Neal Street 60 feet to a stake corner also corner of lot No. 18, thence
 S. 74 1/4 E. 200 feet to a stake corner of lots No. 30 & 31, thence S. 82 1/4 W. 60 feet to a stake
 also corner of lots No. 39 & 30 thence N. 74 1/4 W. 200 feet to the beginning corner and contain

 person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
