KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

R. M. McSee of Greenville

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of *Twelve hundred and fifty-*

Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

W.H. Irvin of the same place

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *W.H. Irvin*, all that piece of land tract or land, situate lying and being in Greenville Township, in the County of Greenville, and in the State aforesaid, East of the City, and about two miles from the Court House adjoining lands of Walter Holcomb, Mrs. Susan A. Henderson, Tully Bell, and others, containing twenty five (25) acres, more or less. Said tract of land is the same that was to be sold and conveyed by Joseph J. Gettenger by general warranty deed, bearing date April 13, 1894, and which is to be recorded in the Register's office for the County and State aforesaid. The description in said deed is hereby set forth and made part of this instrument and is as follows: Being part of tract originally granted to John Johnson, and given by Charles Green to his daughter Emily Hammond and her heirs bounded as follows, on South by road leading from Greenville City to Greenville Court House, measuring Four hundred and twenty five feet on said road and on the East by lands of W.B. Holcomb, separated by a line running N. 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. and continuing N. 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ crossing the G.P.A.P. tract and cornering on Rock, Bounded on the North-east by lands of W.B. Holcomb and Eliza Hammond, separated by a line running N. 36 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. and measuring 28.00 to a Rock corner, Bounded on the East by lands of Daniel Green and lands known as the Webster lands, separated from same by a line running S. 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. and measuring 5.30. Bounded on the South-west by lands of the said Susan A. Henderson, and separated by a line running S. 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 7.70 and crossing in the river of Spring Lead; then it runs up the water of the Lead to the Grand C.R.R. and then continues up the gully to a Plumtree X whence to the starting point on the public road, by a line running S. 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 35' to a stake corner, more particularly described by a Plat made by H. A. Hudson, February 7, 1894. This is the same land conveyed by deed of Mrs. Susanna M. Henderson to Joseph J. Gettenger, bearing date February 10, 1896, and duly recorded in the Register's office in book A. A. 1. at page 408.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said *W.H. Irvin and*
to his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And *I* do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors, and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said *W.H. Irvin & to his*

Heirs and Assigns, against *Mrs.* and *my* Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
