in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by The Grand Lodge of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows of the State of South Carolina, its Heirs and Assigns forever (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Grand Lodge of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows of the State of South Carolina, its Heirs and Assigns forever all that certain tract of land in said County and State on the Bailey Bridge road known as the Carpin Vineyard, containing seventy two and one half acres, more or less, and also all that other tract of land adjoining the aforesaid tract, beginning at a stake and running thence $7\frac{1}{4}$ S. $47\frac{1}{4}$ W. 12. 87 to a point thence S. 13. E. 11. 10 to a stump thence $7\frac{1}{4}$ S. $7\frac{1}{4}$ E. 7. 40 to the beginning corner containing four acres more or less and being a part of Carpin Vineyard, being the aforesaid tract of land conveyed by D. And we do hereby bind us and our Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
