then N. 48¹/₄ W. 16.68 ft. stone thence N. 4¹/₄ E. 8.29 ft. stone in road, then N. 40 W. 8.26
ft. stone in road, thence S. 18³/₄ W. 16.56 ft. to stone thence S. 10 W. 34.7 ft. to stone thence S. 17³/₄

Burdett is to pay to the above said Joseph Burdett the sum of thirty three dollars per annum by the 15th day of November in every year annually and in case he fails to pay such sum as aforesaid then this conveyance is to be null and void and the said Joseph & Burdett are to have the right without suit or process to immediately enter upon the said premises and claim the same as with which shall happen to it. And I do hereby bind myself and J. M. Burdett Hears, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said and his

Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
