KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Perry Beattie, the owner of the above described land, and in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Perry Beattie of the City of Greenville in the State of South Carolina, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Perry Beattie, all that piece or lot of land

in Greenville County, State of South Carolina in the City of Greenville on the east side of Anderson Street, beginning at a post marking a corner formerly indicated by a red oak tree 3X 0.M. being corner of Nelson Street and running S. 14° 45' W. 5.25 chains (approximately) to a stone 3X 0.M. formerly a large black oak; thence N. 67° 45' E. 44½ square feet to an iron pin 3X 0.M. in Anderson Street; thence with Anderson Street, N. 22° 45' E. 5.10 chains to the beginning. The above strip is shown out as plat made by J. N. Southern March 20th, 1902. By this Deed I convey all of my right, title and interest whatsoever in said lot or strip to said Perry Beattie.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Perry Beattie his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Perry Beattie his

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
