 Creek, Waters of Reedy River, bounded by lands belonging to
 John R. Ostes, Jas. L. Givens, Col. R. Arnold and the
 Captain having Miles P. Givens. Having the following described
 lines to west Beginning on a stone #111 in the public road
 leading to Dr. Givens. Said stone being on J. Ostes' line, thence
 N 74 W 18° 13' to stone #111 on 100 A. tract, hence line, thence N 12°
