 being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina,
 containing Forty acres more or less, lying on Water Little Rockey
 Creek, of Saluda River, and adjoining Lands of J. S. Kilgore 1st
 Thomas Shepard, 2d Mrs. S. C. Montgomery, both having the following
 Metes and Bounds and Courses and Distances to wit; Beginning
 at a stone 3x4 ft. M. on a branch and running thence N. 98 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 30.85'
 to a stone 3x4 in place of Stump; thence N. 10 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 11.5' to a stone 3x4 ft. M. in a
