 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jno M. Steel.

All my right title and undivided one half interest of
 me and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City
 of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in the second Ward of
 said City on the South Side of Ann Street, bounded as
 follows: Beginning at an iron pin stake on South side of
 Ann Street and running with said street N. $80^{\circ} 15' E$. Sixty-four
 feet to an iron stake thence S. $13^{\circ} 45' E$. One Hundred Thirty
 Seven and five-tenths feet to an iron stake thence S. $76^{\circ} 15' E$,
 Sixty-four feet to an iron stake thence N. $13^{\circ} 45' E$. two hundred
 and one feet to beginning corner. Being lot No. 7 in plat
 border by J. E. Sirrine October 1st 1895 of land of Olympia B.
 and Elsie E. Ernest and the same conveyed to Jno M. Steel,
 and myself by Harry C. Harkley, on the 18th day of February, 1905.

 and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Jno M. Steel.

 person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
