W. 2<sup>o</sup> N. 100 feet to the South end thereof; thence with South end Avenue S. 2<sup>o</sup> W. 100 feet West stone of 8; thence N. 63<sup>o</sup> E. 100 feet to a stone 3 x; thence N. 63<sup>o</sup> E. 100 feet to the beginning corner. Containing a little less than one fourth part of an acre, being the same more or less and known as lot #150 in survey made by H. A. Henderson for G. H. Green, being part of the Dickson Annex, being part of the land sold to me by L. T. Hammond.
