Dollars, to and in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Willie G. Dickey

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Willie G. Dickey, all my undivided one half interest, in all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville State aforesaid containing forty three and one half acres more or less, and bounded as follows: To wit; adjoining lands of J. M. Thompson Esq. N. & H. Morris, formerly owned by H. St. Whitmore and J. M. Jones, et al with the following metes and bounds:

Begining at a stone in the old road or "Carpenters Line" and running thence N. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 14.80 to a Sweet gum 3 x 0. m; thence N. 59 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 4.50 to a stone 3 x 0. m; thence S. 75 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 19.75 to a stone 3 x m; thence S. 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 20.20 to a stone 3 x m; on the old public road; thence with said Old road 15.03 to the beginning corner, being the same lot of land conveyed by H. E. Maxwell, et al to Mary H. Dickey by deed of Feb. 22, 1902 and recorded in R. M. C. office, said County and state, Book, I. I. L. at page 597 and being the same lot of land conveyed by Mary H. Dickey to Willie G. Dickey and James R. Dickey by deed of Oct. 13, 1903 and recorded in R. M. C. Office said County and state Book J. J. F. at page 849.

And I do hereby bind myself and my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Willie G. Dickey his

Heirs and Assigns, against every and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
