in the State aforesaid, & County of Greenville, in consideration of the sum of two hundred and seventy-five Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by A. L. Robertson in the State aforesaid & County of Greenville (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said A. L. Robertson, his heirs and assigns a certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated in Greenville County State aforesaid on waters of Rally Creek. Beginning on a chest of wood 3 x 4 ft. State line; thence with said State line to a rock 3 x 4 ft. Russell corner; thence with Mr. Russell line N. 33° E. to a rock 3 x 3.50; thence S. 50° E. to a small hickory 3 x. 10; thence N. 37 1/4° E. distance not known to a state on Salmon line; thence S. 69° E. 43.06 to the beginning chestnut 3 x one of said tracts was willed to A. L. Robertson by H. W. Robertson the other was conveyed to him by E. M. Dred the 1<sup>st</sup> day of Feb. 1874, the 2<sup>nd</sup> tract contains two hundred and seventy three and one fourth acres, more or less.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident of appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said A. L. Robertson, his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my A. L. Robertson, his Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said A. L. Robertson, his

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
