WHEREAS, Sarah A. Croft, formerly Sarah A. Cox, late of the County of Greenville, South Carolina, departed this life on the 1st of May 1896, leaving of force her last Will and Testament, which was duly Probated: AND WHEREAS, she died seized and possessed of the land within described and gave to the Trustees under said Will full power to sell and dispose of the same, and further name in said Will as Trustees, Tench Cox and Franklin Cox, Sr., with power to the survivor to fill any vacancy, and said Franklin Cox, Sr., having died, the said Tench Cox appointed Francis S. Cox to fill said vacancy and the full power of sale and disposition is now vested in us, now

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *P. A. Morgan, his heirs and assigns forever*, all

that lot or parcel of land situated in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina and bounded as follows: Beginning Two Hundred feet East of Crown Street at the South-East corner of the lot conveyed by said Sarah A. Cox to A. P. Davis on the 15th day of June 1889, and recorded in Book V. 1. at page 138; thence with the line of that lot N. 27° E. one hundred and forty feet to the North East corner of the said Davis lot, which corner is now on a new street thirty feet in width not yet opened out, but to run from Crown Street along the North line of said Davis lot and prolonged in a straight line until it strikes Mrs. S. V. Peattie's line as shown on plan, which street may at any time be opened by the said Morgan or the City of Greenville and is hereby dedicated to the public, thence S. 58 1/2 W. along said new street until it intersects the line of said S. V. Peattie; thence towards North street along said Mrs. Peattie's line until it strikes the North East corner of P. A. Morgan's North Street lot, thence towards Crown Street along the back line of the lots of said P. A. Morgan, Oscar Hodges, and H. Eubel to the beginning corner.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said *P. A. Morgan, his Heirs and Assigns forever*.

And we do hereby bind ourselves, successors, Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said *P. A. Morgan, his heirs and assigns against the heirs, legatees and devisees of the said Sarah A. Croft*.
Heirs and Assigns against ourselves and successors, Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
