 now under and by virtue of the Power vested in us by said will, as  
 the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred

Dollars, to use, in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents byP. A. Morgan

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said P. A. Morgan, his heirs and assigns forever, all

that lot or parcel of land situated in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina and bounded as follows; Beginning Two Hundred feet East of Brown Street at the South-East corner of the lot conveyed by said Sarah A. Box to A. P. Davis on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June 1889, and recorded in Book 22 at page 138; thence with the line of that lot N. 27 1/2 E one hundred and fifty feet to the North East corner of the said Davis lot, which corner is now on a new street thirty feet in width, not yet opened out, but to run from Brown Street along the North line of said Davis lot and prolonged in a straight line until it strikes Mrs. S. V. Peattie's line as shown on plan, which street may at any time be opened by the said Morgan or the City of Greenville and is hereby dedicated to the public; thence S 58 1/2 E along said new street until it intersects the line of said S. V. Peattie; thence towards North street along said Mrs. Peattie's line until it strikes the North East corner of P. A. Morgan's North Street lot, thence towards Brown Street along the back line of the lots of said P. A. Morgan, Oscar Scott, and H. Eubel to the beginning corner.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said P. A. Morgan, his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And we do hereby bind ourselves, successors, Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said P. A. Morgan, his heirs and assigns, against the heirs, legatees and devisees of the said Sarah A. Box, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
