 sell and release unto the said John W. Pike all that piece of land, or tract of  
 land lying and being in Ayston Township of the  
 State and County aforesaid, and having the  
 following metes and bounds. Beginning at a rock  
 on bridge; thence N. 18 W. 65° to a post oak; thence  
 S. 78 W. 15° to a stake on Verdin line; thence S. 13 E. 9.02  
 to Lewis Pikes corner; thence N. 70 E. 15.62 to the begin-  
 ning corner, and containing eleven and four-  
 fifth (11 1/5) acres, more or less.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or  
 in anywise incident or pertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the
