Bishop of the same County and State (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George W. Bishop his heirs and assigns forever all that piece, parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, about twelve miles from the City of Greenville, on the Purcumb road, and hath the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake in neighborhood road, corner of A. Griffiths line, and run: thence S. 83 1/2 N. 22.00 to Purcumb road: thence S. 20 N. 4.90 to an angle in said road: thence S. 65 N. 5.21 to angle in said road: thence S. 72 E. 8.20 to a stone Penson's corner: thence S. 69 1/2 E. 20.26 to a stone near branch: thence S. 24 1/2 N. 10.10 to a stone: thence N. 66 1/4 E. 28.00 to a Q-gum, Griffiths corner in road: thence N. 39 N. 9.60 to a stake in road: thence N. 40 N. 13.70 to a stake in road: thence N. 27 N. 8.20 to the Beginning corner, containing eighty-five and three fourths acres more or less, adjoining lands of J.
