KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Mary E. Trotter and James H. Trotter,  
 in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twenty-three Hundred  
and fifty-five Dollars, to me, in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by  
Lillian L. McGroarty,  
 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain,  
 sell and release unto the said Lillian L. McGroarty, all those two certain Lots or parcels  
 of land in Greenville City, said County and state on the Clash side  
 of lot & & 24, as follows: (1) all that certain lot, bordering on the  
 North of Spillard street, and Clash of all unnamed street,  
 containing one and three-fourths ( $1\frac{3}{4}$ ) acres, more or less, being  
 all of the lot whereon we now reside, being the lot conveyed to Mary  
 E. Taylor by J. W. Brooke, Dec. 3, 1863, recorded in Book L. S. 214 and by  
 said Mary E. Taylor to James Trotter August 18, 1866, recorded in  
 Book L. S. 215, and by last named in full, has sold heirs at law and  
 distributees of said James Trotter now deceased. (2) all that other  
 tract of land lying just West of said unnamed street conveyed  
 by J. A. Peterson to James H. Trotter on February 10, 1904, recorded  
 in Book L. S. L. 344 containing two (2) acres, more or less,  
 consisting of two original portions (a) one and three-fourths ( $1\frac{3}{4}$ )  
 acres, more or less, being the same conveyed by James Trotter  
 to said J. A. Peterson March 14, 1892, Book P. G. 298 and (B) a  
 triangular parcel immediately North of said  $1\frac{3}{4}$  acres, Lot  
 being conveyed to J. A. Peterson by Alabanda M. Peterson  
 August 6, 1882, recorded in Book C. 437.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or  
 in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the  
 said Lillian L. McGroarty, her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And we do hereby bind us and our Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant  
 and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Lillian L. McGroarty, her

Heirs and Assigns, against us and our Heirs, and against every  
 person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
