Containing Twenty-three and one half (23½) Acres more or less and hath such marks bounds otc.as follows, viz: Beginning at co.. stone on State road. Thence \$89 \times 24.50 to a stone. W 9.17 to a stone. Thence \$56½ W 2.10 to a stone. Thence N 52 W 12.20 to a stone & P.O. stump Thence \$42 W 18.00 to a stone and P.O. Thence along State Road \$7½ E 1.50 to the beginning. Bounded by lands of H.S. Willis, J.T. Kellar, S.E. Coster and John C. Lynn and Styles lands.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said John C. Lynn his heirs and assigns forever.

And we do hereby bind ourselves as trustees and our successors and assigns, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John Lynn, his heirs and assigns, against us and our successors and assigns, and the heirs and assigns of Thomas Wadsworth, deceased, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
