NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, the said Emma Burton in consideration of the foregoing premises, and the further consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Henry Walker and Abbie Walker, both of the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have disposed of the custody, and do hereby dispose of the custody and tuition of the said Lucile Means unto the said Henry Walker and Abbie Walker, and their heirs, for and during the whole of such time as the said Lucile Means shall remain under the age of twenty-one years, and the possession of the said Lucile Means to the said Henry Walker and Abbie Walker and their heirs is hereby conveyed.

To have and to hold the said Lucile Means for such time as aforesaid unto the said Henry Walker and Abbie Walker, and their heirs.

Provided, that the said Henry Walker and Abbie Walker, and their heirs shall at all times during the time aforesaid provide for the said Lucile Means in sickness and in health, and at all times to supply her with suitable food and clothing, and shall also cause the said Lucile Means within such time to read and write, and give to her such further education and advantages as the said Henry Walker and Abbie Walker may feel inclined to do so.
