-wife and children and the education of my children at any time or times and from time to times, so often as the same may be necessary or advisable in the opinion of such trustee.

3. In trust, upon the death of my said wife, to pay all medical and other expenses for her last illness and funeral, and of a suitable tombstone to her memory, and to re-invest all profits thereafter arising and allow the same to accumulate until my ^{ou} youngest child shall attain the age of twenty-one years, with full power and authority, however in and to said trustee, to apply the whole or any part of the income and the whole or any part of the principal of such trust fund to the support and education of my children, if in his opinion it is advisable so to do; and when my youngest child shall attain the age of twenty-one, or in the event that my youngest child shall die before attaining that age, then when my oldest child shall attain such age (and upon the death of my wife as aforesaid), in trust to reduce the whole of such trust property to money, including the accumulations, if any and to distribute and pay over all that may then be remaining to and among my issue, share and share alike, per stirpes and not per capita; freed and discharged of all trusts; so that the child or children of either of my children who may have died before the period of distribution shall take among them the share of which his, her or their parent would have been entitled if then living, and in the event that at the time of my wife's death none of my issue shall then be living, in trust to pay over the whole fund then remaining in the hands of such trustee to my mother, Mrs. Edith M. Hoke, or if she be then dead, to such persons as may at that time be entitled to inherit her estate under the laws of the State of South Carolina governing the distribution of intestates estates. And I do hereby covenant and agree with the said L.O. Patterson and his successor or successors in the trust that I will from time to time, upon the demand of the trustee hereunder for the time being, execute and deliver whatever other instruments of writing, deeds, conveyances and assurances in the law may be reasonably required for the better assigning, assuring, conveying and confirming unto the said trustee for the time being, for the uses and purposes of this trust, the whole or any part or parts of the property and estate hereby granted; and this trust is to be accepted upon the express condition that neither the trustee herein named nor any successor or successors in the trust shall be or become responsible or liable for any destruction, deterioration, loss injury or damage which may be done or occur to the estate or premises hereby granted, nor for any interest not actually received by such trustee, nor for any other cause, matter or thing except his or their own wilful and intentional breach of the trusts herein expressed and contained: provided always, and it is hereby further declared, that if the trustee hereby appointed, or any future trustee or trustees hereof, shall die (either before or after his or their acceptance of such trust), become insane, go to reside abroad, desire to be discharged from, renounce, decline or become incapable or unfit to act in the trusts of these presents while said trusts or any of them shall be subsisting, then, and in every or any such cases, it shall be lawful for my said wife, Grayson M. Hoke, and after her death for my said Mother Edith M. Hoke, by any writing or writings under her hand, attested by two or more witnesses; and after the death of both my said wife and mother, then for the executors or administrators of the then last acting trustee (whether such executors or administrators shall be willing to act in other respects or not) by any writing or writings under his, her or their hand or hands, attested by two or more witnesses, to nominate and substitute any person or persons (except the future husband of my said wife Grayson M. Hoke, and the future husband of my daughter Edith Mills Hoke) to be trustee or trustees hereof, in the place -
