-of the trustee or trustees so dying, becoming insane, going to reside, abroad desiring to be discharged, renouncing, declining or becoming incapable of unfit to act, as aforesaid; and that so often as any new trustee or trustees hereof shall be appointed as aforesaid, all of tite lands, tenements and hereditaments which shall for the time being be held upon the trusts hereof shall be thereupon conveyed, assigned and transferred, respectively, in such manner that the warme same may become legally and effectually vested in the acting trustee or trustees hereof for the time being, to and for the same uses and upon the same trusts and with and subject to the same powers and provisions as are herein declared and contained of and concerning the same hereditaments and premises respectively; or such of the same uses, trusts, powers and provisions as shall then be subsisting or capable of taking effect; and tat every new trustee, to be from time to time appointed as aforesaid, shall thenceforth be competent in all things to act in the execution of the trusts hereof as fully and effectually, and with all the same powers and authority to all purposes whatsoever, as if he had hereby been originally appointed a trustee in the place of the trustee to whom he shall, whether immediately or otherwise, succeed.
