Gowerfor a lot located on Cooke Street near the Air Line Depot to be used for the erection of a Church for the congregation that now worship in the Church on Gibbs St.

The motion was unanimously adopted and William Froneberger, A.P. Davis, Robt. Thacker Trustees: J.A. Brown Presiding Elder and J.H. Park, Pastor were appointed by the Conference to make the exchange.
