Riley, his heirs and assigns forever,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Ward 6, of the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on Sullivan Street and right-of-way of the Southern Railway, Greenville & Columbia Division, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Greenville & Columbia Division of the Southern Railway Companys right-of-way and Sullivan Street; thence S. 67-3/4 E. 2. chs. to rock XNM, near branch; thence N. 23 E. up the left side of said branch to stake XNM, in Tratters line, 3.12 chs.; thence N. 70 W. 74 lks. to stake XOM; thence S. 46 W. 3.33 chs. to the beginning corner, containing 43/100 of an acre, more or less, and being the same lot of land conveyed by Chas M.
