This Contract made and entered into this 15th day of June 1916 between C. F. Griffin and Enoree Power Company, witnesseth as follows: The said E. F. Griffin for and in consideration of the sum of \$100 in hand paid by the said Enoree Power Company, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, doth grant unto the said Enoree Power Company, its successors or assigns, the right and privilege to raise a dam on Log Shoals on Reedy River to such height as they or their successors or assigns may desire.

It is further agreed as part of this contract that should, after the raising of such dam, the lands of the said E. F. Griffin become in any way injured or damaged by the water from backling by such dam as said Power Company may raise on said stream, the said Enoree Power Company hereby binds itself, its successors or assigns, to pay the amount of such damage to the said E. F. Griffin heirs, executors, administrators or assigns. The amount of such damage, in case the parties hereto cannot agree upon the same, shall be arrived at and fixed in the following manner, to wit: The said E. F. Griffin heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, is to select one arbitrator, and the said Enoree Power Company, to select another, and these two arbitrators to select a third; if these two cannot agree upon such third arbitrator then he is to be selected by Clerk of Court, and if he will not make such selection, then such selection to be made by Probate Judge; and if he will not, then
