WHEREAS, on the 17th, day of March, A.D. 1905, A.L. Garrison and the National Light and Thorium Company did enter into an agreement which is duly recorded in book M.M.M. on page 34I in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance of said County and State, and WHEREAS, said agreement of March 17th, 1905 was subsequently amended by a supplementary agreement dated the ninth lay of March, 1906. and recorded in book Q.Q.Q. at page 42 in the Register's office aforesaid, endWHEREAS, it is desire of the parties to said agreement

to further modify the same, now therefore,
This agreement, made this I4th day of May, A.D. 1906, by and between the said A.L. Garrison
of Greenville County, South Carolina, and the said National Light and Thorium Company, a
corporation of Delaware. Witnesseth, that in consideration of the premises and of the
mutual agreements hereinafter mentioned, and of the sum of One dollar paid by each of the parties hereto to the other, receipt of which is hereby severally acknowledged, it is agreed as follows:

First- the said Garrison agrees to a reduction of the annual payment provided for by the supplementarl agreement of March 9th, 1906, Second the said Company agrees hat mining operations shall be confind to the bed and runs of the branch on said Garrisons land between J.M. Riddle's lower line with said Garrison and the forks of the branch about 250 yards up the branch, and to such strips of bottom land on the sides of the branch not to exceed forty feet wide extending up the branch from Riddle's line to a shoal about 75 yards below the forks of the branch, such ditches as may be neccessary may be run on the banks of the branch and dams may be constructed and maintained on the branch provided the water is not backed up above the forks of the branch.

Third, it is mutually agreed that the land-owner shall mine the monozite for the Company in the area above mentioned, the bottom land to be worked out at any time convenient to the land-owner within five years from the date of this agreement, and the branch bed to be worked not less frequently then every two years during the remainder of the term of the agreement of March, I7th, I905., the land-owner shall receive from the Company the sum of ten cents per pound of pure monozite for mining the sand, which sum he agrees to accept in full payment for said mining, the Company however, paying him the revalties provided by the original agreement, less any advances which may have been made to him, and furnishing him with necessary tools, the sand thus mined is to be delivered to the representative of the said Company on the mine weekly, or at such other times as may be hereafter agreed upon, if the land-owner does not work out the sand as above provided then the company shall have the right to work out the sand itself, but as long as the landowner does work it out in accordance with the above agreement the company shall not have the right to mine the sand itself.

Fourth, this agreement may be terminated by the land owner in the event of his selling the land covered by this agreement, by giving the company three months written notice of the sale of the land. Fifth- It is mutually agreed that such provisions of the original agreement of March 17th, 1905 and the supplementary agreement of March, 9th, 1906 as are not modified herein shall remain in full force and effect during all of the remainder of the term of the said original agreement.
