That the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common f or a Religious, Educationa 1, Social, F raternal, Charitable or other, elecmosynary purposed or any two or more of sa id purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is abvoc stated, or fot the insurance of life, he alth, accid ent or property, and that Three days notice in the Greenville Daily News, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville, has been given that the af oresaid Declaration would be filed. AND WHEREAS, That said Declarants and Pe titioners further declared and affimed. First, their names and residences are as above given. Second The name of the proposed Corporation is THE JACKSON ORPHAN-ASYLUM, Third The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters to be located is Greenville, S.C. Fourth, The purpose of the said Proposed Cor poration is to provide and maintain a home for Orphan and other needy and helpless children, where they are to be cared for until they reach such age as they can provide for themselves, and where they are to be taught or trained to do such work as they can, or may be fitted for, and where they are to be given such training and education as the managers, Trustees and other officers of this association may deem advisable to there be st interests. Fifth, The names and residences of all managers, Trustees, Directors or other officers are as follows: Alice Hall, President; Hattie Wakefield, Vice-Presid ent; NaMnie Echols Secretary Nittie Williams Corresponding Secretary; C. H. Wak efield, Treasure; Sixth, That they desired to be incorporated in pupetuity.

NOW THEREF ORE, I.J. Gentt, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by Chapter XLVIII., A rticle II., Code od I902, and Acts amenditory thereto, do hereby declare the said organization to be a body politic and corporate with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities, confered by the said Chapter XLVIII., Article II., Code of I902, and Acts amenditory thereto Given under my hand and the seal of the State, at Columbia, this I4th, day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and six and in the one hundred and thirtieth year of the Independence of the Unites States of America.
