Article of Agreement made and entered into this July 5th, 1906 by and between Beulah-Duckworth Knox, formerly of Anderson County and wife James T. knox, and Mrs Harriet Rycroft, of Greenville, Said County and State WITHESSETH: - (I) WHEREAS James T. Knox, has several times deserted and mistreated said Beulah Duckworth Knox, and has failed to provide any support for his infant child by said Beulah Duckworth Knox , being named Pearl-Knox, aged sixteen months on July 20, 1906, being borned on March 20th, 1905, and whereas, said Beulah Duckworth Knox is unable to support and care for said child, which is now sick with some chronic disease, and whereas said less Harriet Rycroft has expressed a desire to care and care for said child, and has promised to rear, nurture, educate and train said child now, the said Beulah Duckworth Knox has this day by these presents surrendered, ransferred, and give over to said Harriet Rycroft, all her parental rights, powers, privileges, and claim in and to said child, until said child shall be of full lawful age and twenty one years old. (2) That inconsideration of the premises, Mrs. Harriet Rycroft has this day undertaken, promised and agreed to care for, support and maintain said Pearl Knox, and give her an education suitable to her station of life, and and have her properly treated and nursed in sickness, and to treat as an apprentice ought and all times to be treated and taught the useful and proper duties of housewifely and domestic arts. (3) Each of the parties hereto binds herself to assist and protect the rights of the other under this contract and agreement, against any attempt said James T. Knox, may make to recover possession of said child as he is unfit and unworthy to have the rearing and training of said child.
