And Whereas, That said Declaraants and Petitioners futher declared and affirmed: FIRST. Their names and residences are as above given. SECCOND. The name of the proposed Corporation is BLYTHE RIFLES. THIRD. The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is Greenville, & located FOURTH. The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is Social and Military.
FIFTH. The names and residences of all Managers, Trustees, Directors or other officers are as follows: T.C. Gower, President. Wyatt A. Suybt, Treasurer. W. M. Smith, Secretary.
Sixth. That they desired to be incorporated in purputuity. Now, Therefore, I. J. T. Gantt, Secretary of State, by virtue of authority in me vosted, by Chapter XLVIII., Article II., Code of 1902, and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby declare the said organization to be a body politic and corporate, with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities, conferred by said Chapter XLVIII., Article II., Code of 1902, and Acts amendatory thereto.
