Know ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That Wm.G.Sirrine, has agreed to sell to Mollie Gordon, a certain lot or tract of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina. in the City of Greenville at the corner of Rhett Street, and Marion Place beginning at said corner and running thence with Marion Place N.18-30 W. One Hundred feet to a stake; thence in a line parallel to Rhett St, in a Westerly direction fifty-four feet to a stake; thence S.18-30 E. one hundred feet to a stake on Rhett Street, and thence with Rhett Street to the beginning corner and known as lot number seventeen on a plat in my office. on condition that she shall pay all taxes thereon and also the sum of Eight hundred and Fifty Dollars in the following manner: Ten dollars on the first day of each calender month after date. until the full purchase price is paid, with interest on same from date at eight percent per annum until paid, to be computed and paid annually, and if unpaid to bear interest until paid at same rate as principal, and in case said sum or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or through legal proceedings of any kind, then in addition the sum of Ten per cent for attorneys fee, and said Mollie Gordon, having given her note for the amount due, as aforesaid. damages, or may enforce payment of said note.
