

The State of South Carolina, (Charter 50 §. Pd.)

Executive Department

By the Secretary of State.

Whereas: Dr. A.A. Odom, Gardan, Ala. Dr. M.M. Land, Cottondale, Fla and Dr. J.D. Odom, Gardan, Ala. did on the 27th, day of August, 1907 file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves setting forth:

- First: The names and Residences of the said Petitioners to be as above given.
- Second: The name of the proposed Corporation be that of The Globe Optical Company,
- Third: The principal place of business of the Corporation will be Greenville, S.C?
- Fourth: The general purpose of the corporation, and the nature of business it proposes to do. Manufactureing optical goods, buying and selling optical goods, Jewelry, Watches, Clocks, Cutlery, Camereass, and Photographies, general supplies, for wholesale and retail trade, The conduct of general optical busi
- Fifth: the amount of the capital stock to be divided into five thousand dollars and the number shares into which the same is to be divided into twenty for the par value of One hundred dollars each.
- Sixth: The Capital stock to be paid for in the Declaration and Petition.

And Whereas on 27th, day of August, 1907, the date above named, Petitioners were commissioned by me a Board of Corporators: And Whereas, the said Board of Corporators on the 4th day of September 1907, did file with the Secretary of State their return in writing, over their signature, certifying that they had done the things, that pursuant to publish notice as required in the commission of the said Board of Corporators, the books of subscription to the Capital stock of the aforesaid Company were duly opened and that thereupon exceeding fifty per centum of the Capital stock was subscribed by bona fide stockholders; that thereupon a meeting of stockholders was called and the aforesaid Company duly organized by the election of a Board of Directors, and other necessary officers, that, furthermore, they have complied with all requirements of the Code of Laws of the State of South Carolina, of 1902, and all Acts or parts of Acts amenditory thereto;

Now therefore, I. R.M. McCown, Secretary of State by virtue of the Authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amenditory thereto do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina under the name and for the purpose indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their Charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance in each County where such Corporation shall have a business office.
