

State of South Carolina, (Agreement)
Greenville County.

Whereas, on the 17th, day of March 1905, P.D. Huff and J. Addie Huff of said County and State did grant and convey certain mineral rights and privileges unto the National Light and Thorium Company by an agreement recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance of said County and State in book MMM at page 340,

And Whereas, in said agreement it was provided that if operations under said agreement were suspended at any time for more than twelve consecutive months then it should be null and void.

And Whereas, it is desired to amend said agreement so as to provide how it may be kept in force from year to year at the option of the holder thereof, Now therefore,

This Writing witnesseth: That in consideration of the premises and of the sum of Ten-dollars (\$10.) to us in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we, P.D. Huff, and J. Addie Huff do hereby covenant and agree that the agreement now held by said Company be and is hereby amended so that it may be kept in force and effect from year to year- without the said Company being under any obligation to conduct any operations on the premises described therein, by the annual payment of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) on or before the 17th, day of March of each year hereafter during the continuance of said agreement each payment of ten dollars keeping the said agreement in force for one year beginning on the 17th, day of March, Such payments shall be considered as advancements of Royalties and shall be charged as such to our account, but in no event shall we be required to refund any money thus paid:
